I was dead in my sins. I now live with Christ Jesus in me.... I am alive.... Darkness to light.... Bondage to freedom.... Hate, bitterness, pride, self-centered to Love - Joy - Peace - Kindness – Goodness – Faithfulness – Gentleness & Self-control.

I am different, I am not the same person who walked through the chapel doors on May 29th, 2019. I am changed, the old is gone. I don't even remember her name. Jesus gave me a new name, a new heart.
